

## **CORAL SEA MARINA**







The 5 Gold Anchor Platinum and Superyacht Ready accredited Coral Sea Marina (CSM) features over 520 marina berths, fuel services, a boutique luxury resort, a range of sea-side dinner options, a marina village and premium shore-based facilities. A vessel maintenance boatyard is located on site and lifts vessels up to 75 tonnes.

The marina has 520 berths, 65 suited to boats 30-80m, and of course, CSM is a certified Clean Marina and is also rated Fish Friendly. Its commitment to environmental sustainability is unquestionable and evidenced by it awards and proactive initiatives. In 2022, Coral Sea Marina was voted Best Superyacht Marina in the world by Captains and crew at the 2022 ACREW Superyacht Business Awards.



### HAMILTON ISLAND MARINA







The iconic Hamilton Island Marina is a 5 Gold Anchor and Superyacht Ready accredited marina. It holds the environmental accreditation Clean Marina and is also Fish Friendly. Home to over 400 vessels, the marina caters for vessels up to 45 metres and offers fuel and vessel lifting and maintenance services.

The marina is the centrepiece of Hamilton Island town where this is a wide selection of bars, restaurants and shops. The marina is popular with tourists, cruisers and avid racing sailors who are drawn to the Hamilton Island Yacht Club, home of the renowned Hamilton Island Race Week. The island has a busy airport, a good range of accommodation options and a golf course.



### HAYMAN ISLAND MARINA

Hayman Island is a luxury, private island. The InterContinental Great Barrier Reef Resort is the only hotel on the island and is a sanctuary where time slows down. The marina has 24 berths, catering for vessels up to 45 metres.

Guests of the marina enjoy the luxury facilities of the resort which include vast swimming pools, a range of dining options, water sports, a day spa, fitness centre and secluded beaches.

# CONFIRMATION & CANCELLATION

The tour is strictly limited to delegates who register and attend Marinas26. Priority will be given to delegates from marina facilities. The tour is restricted to 30 delegates and registration will be confirmed to the first 30 paid registrations.
